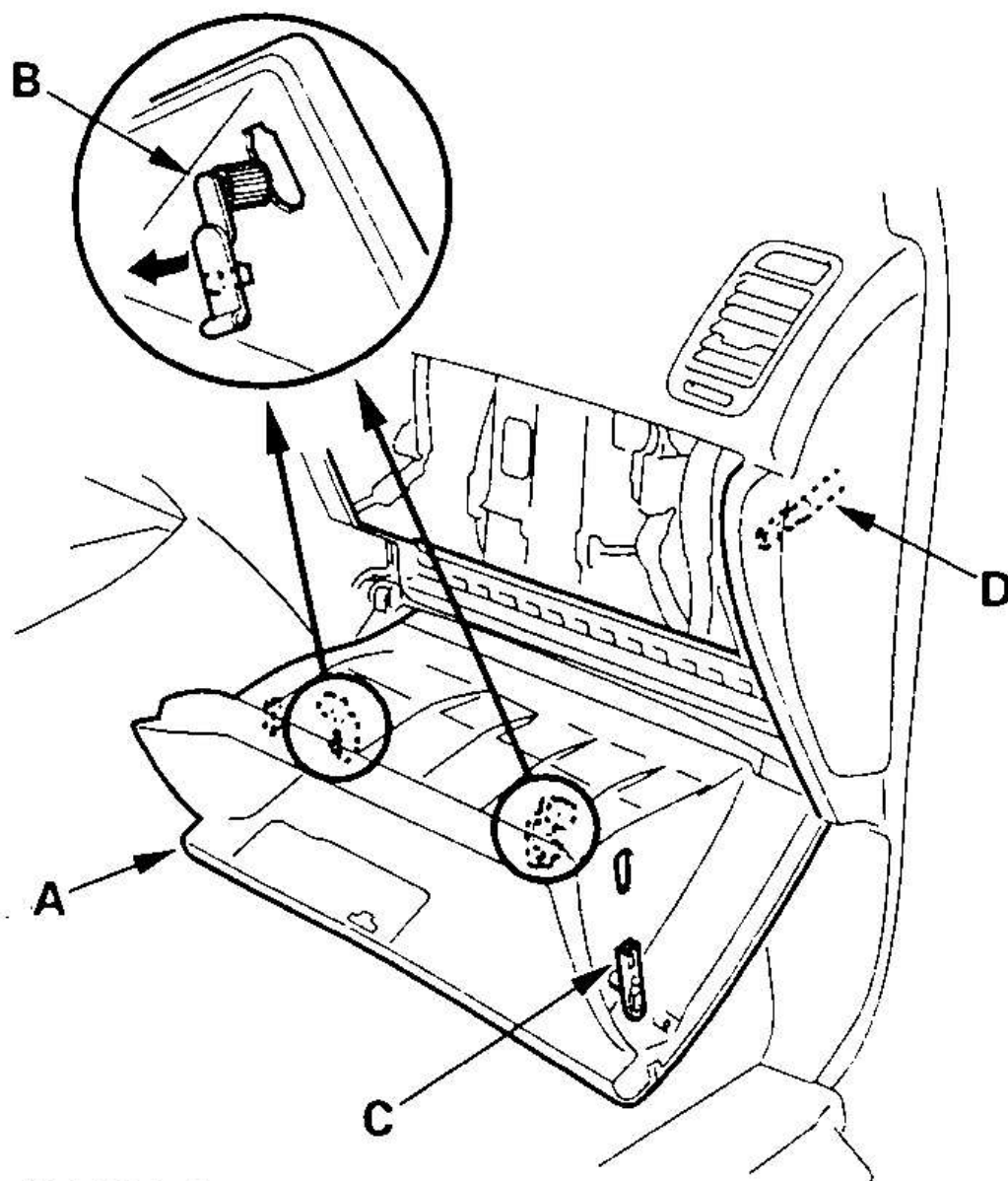

CABIN AIR FILTER

Removal & Installation (2001-2006)

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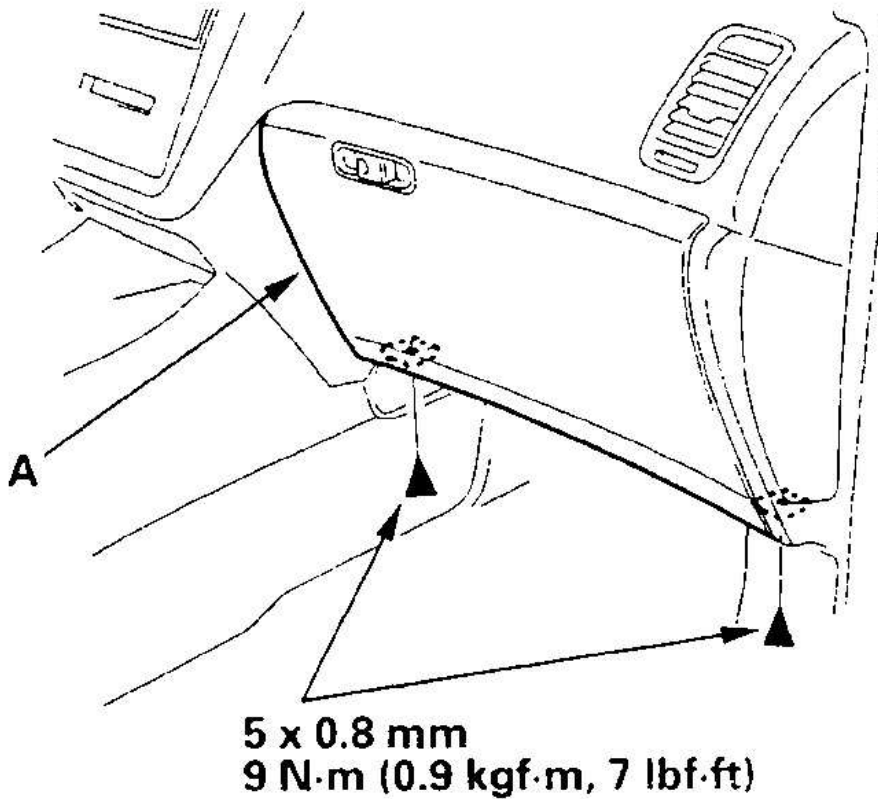
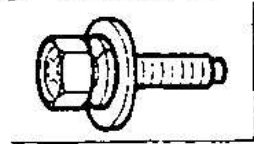
Fig. 1: Removing Glove Box Stops

1. While holding the glove box (A), remove the glove box stop (B) on each side. See **Fig. 1** . Detach the lock (C) from the damper (D).

2. Remove the bolts, then remove the glove box (A). See **Fig. 2** .

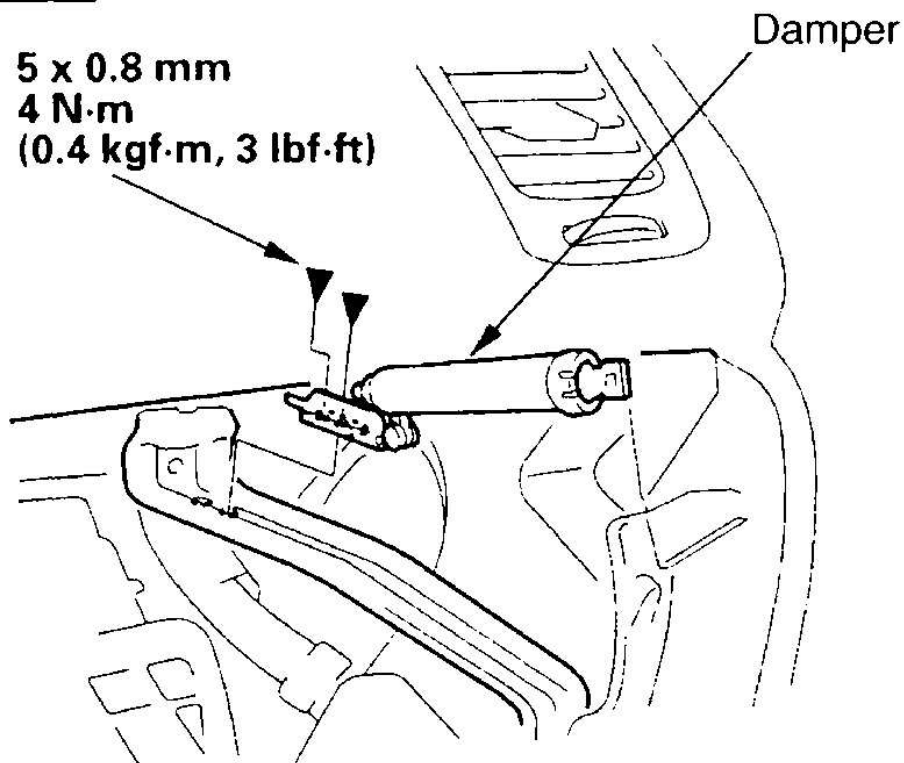
3. Remove the bolts, then remove the damper. See **Fig. 3**.

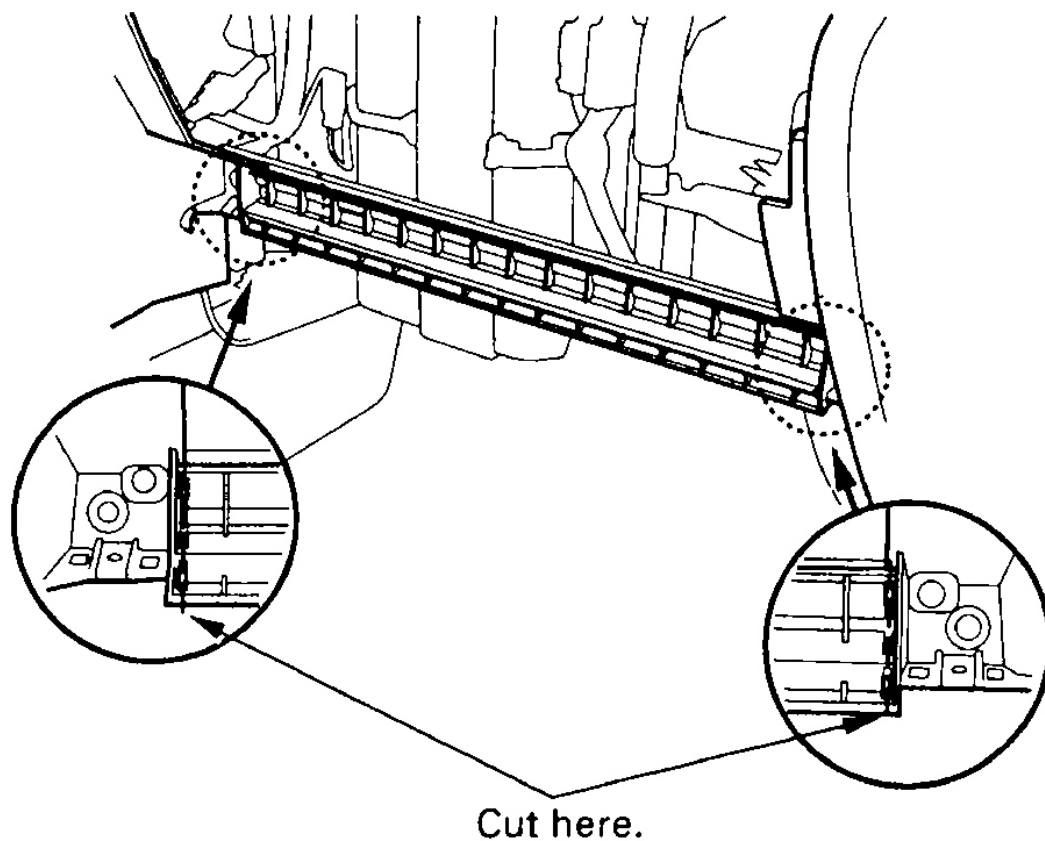


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Fig. 3: Removing Glove Box Damper

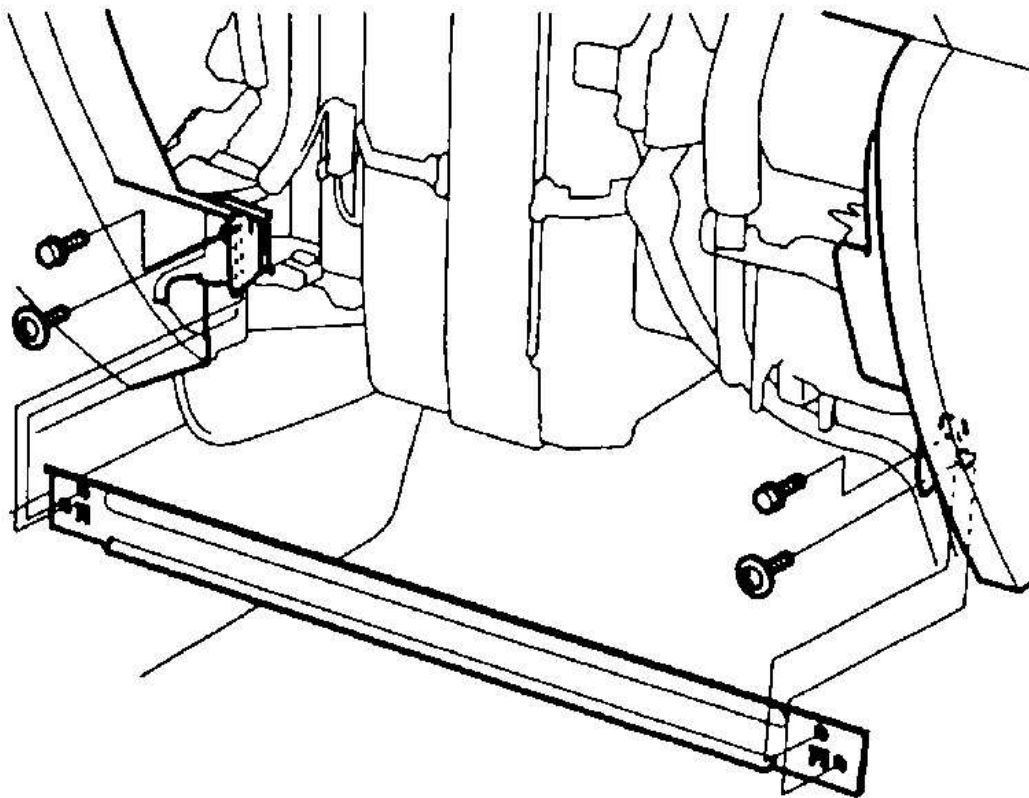
4. If necessary, cut the plastic cross brace in the glove box opening with diagonal cutters in the area shown, and discard it. See **Fig. 4**.

5. Remove the bolts, the screws and the glove box frame. See **Fig. 5**.

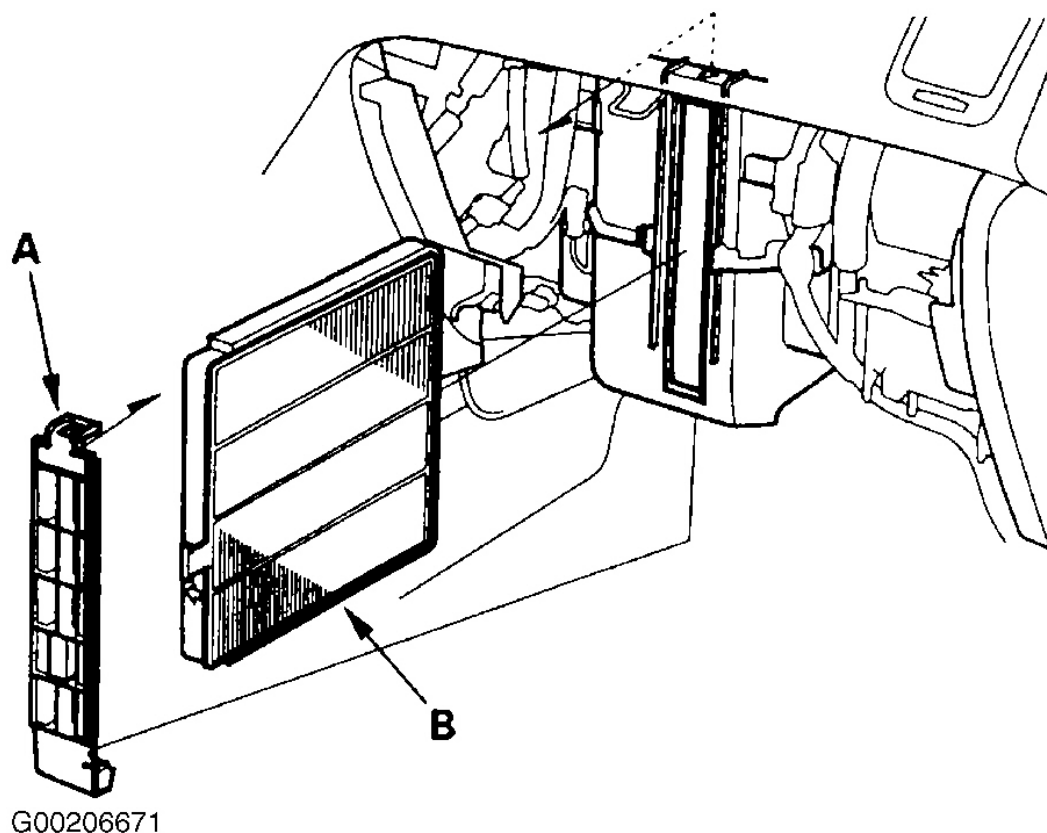


Fig. 6: Removing Dust & Pollen Filter

6. Remove the filter lid (A) from the evaporator, then pull out the dust and pollen filter (B). See **Fig. 6** .
